
## Spiegelhalter Jewellers Shop Mile End Road- Kingsway Models Christmas Download 2021

The download has two sheets including these instructions.

Most of the parts should be fixed to stout card (I used mounting board approximately I.5mm thick), but three pieces marked should be fixed to thin I60gsm card (about the same as a Christmas card) Use a knife and steel rule on a cutting mat to cut the parts out, and Bostik All Purpose adhesive to glue the parts together.

- 1. Cut out the front wall. Carefully remove the window openings. Cut out the window sills. Colour the edges and then glue in place over the printed ones under the windows. Cut out the two windows and glue behind the window openings.
- 2. Cut out the shopfront. Carefully remove the door opening. Colour all the edges with black felt pen. Cut out the shop surround. Colour the edges with black pen. Glue the shopfront behind the shop surround. Ensure the bottom edges are flush, and that there is an equal overlap of the shopfront on each side.
- 3. Glue the shofront/surround in place on the front wall.
- **4.** Cut out the two large side walls. Glue these to the rear of the front wall and use the two brackets glued in place just above the shopfront, to support the corners.
- 5. Cut out the three wall backing pieces. Glue the wider one to the rear of the top edge of the front wall, and add the other two inside the side walls. Colour the top edges of the walls with a dark pencil.
- 6. Cut out the roof. Score and fold along the centre line. Colour the exposed crease with a dark pencil. Glue the roof in place under the two side walls against the rear of the front wall.
- 7. Cut out the front door assembly. Fold and glue the tabs. Glue this assembly behind the door opening. Ensure that the chequered floor is at the bottom!
- 8. Cut out the paving strip. Stand the model over the rear edge of the paving (away from the kerb) and mark the small areas that need to be cut out to allow for the shopfront pillars. Cut the paving accordingly and glue the paving in place. Similar paving is available in the Kingsway Models PAV kit.
- 9. If required the shutter may be trimmed to size and clipped between the shop pillars.
